ELIGIBILITY AND NOMINATIONS:

To be eligible for this race the nominee must qualify for registration with the American Quarter Horse Association and must qualify as an Accredited Louisiana Bred race foal born in 2023 as set forth in the bylaws of the Louisiana Quarter Horse Breeders Association. Nominations may be accepted if AQHA registration is not complete at the time of nomination. **No refunds on nominations or payments.** Horses must be nominated to this futurity and paid to date through the February 15, 2024, payment (or the late payment by May 15, 2024) to be eligible for the 2024 LQHBA Yearling Sale. Register your horses with AQHA and have PARENTAGE DNA verified!!

LQHBA LOUISIANA MILLION (RG1)

Six percent (6%) shall be deducted from the total futurity payments for administrative fees. (Subject to board approval) The added money will not be subject to any deduction. The nominator represents that he/she and all persons for whom he/she is acting have read and are familiar with the rules and regulations of the Louisiana State Racing Commission and the Race Meet and agree to be bound by and comply with the same and which the acts and decisions of the Louisiana State Racing Commission and the Horse Racing Officials, and that all animals shall be subject to the same acts and decisions of the officials, and agree to be bound by the following terms and conditions. All stable reservations and entries in Stakes, and all other races, are received and subject to all conditions, rules and regulations of the Louisiana State Racing Commission and the Association where this race is to be run.

TRIALS - The number of horses in each trial shall be decided by the management. The trials shall be raced under the same conditions as the stakes. The ten (10) fastest qualifiers shall be selected from the trials to participate in the final. If there are more trial races than can be run during one (1) race day, the trial races may be divided and held on separate days. The horses having the five (5) fastest times during the first day of trials and horses having the five (5) fastest times during the second day of trials will qualify for the final. If the front gates on the starting gate fail to open due to a mechanical failure, or if a horse is left behind the gate when the field is dispatched during the running of the trials such horse shall be declared a non-starter and all nominating, sustaining and entry fees shall be refunded from the purse to the owner of said horse. During the running of the final, such horse will be declared a non-starter and shall be classified as a scratched horse and shall be paid last place purse money. In the trials, horses shall be selected on a time basis. Should two or more contestants have the same qualifying time to the limit of the electronic timing device for the final qualifying position or positions, then a draw by random lot shall be conducted as directed by the board of stewards of the host racing facility. Time of horses in the trials will be determined only to the limit of the electrical timer. Should a mechanical failure occur with the electrical timer on any trial, the finalist for that trial will be selected by stopwatch. Exception: Should horses have the same time for the 10th qualifying place in the same race, the winner of that race would have preference. Should a horse be disqualified, he will be given the time of the horse he is immediately placed behind plus 1/10,000 of one second. The decision of the Stewards in all matters shall be final and entries are accepted only on the condition that those persons nominating and/or starting a horse in the trials and/or stakes agree to be bound by their decisions. All trial rules or new rules adopted by the Louisiana State Racing Commission supersede any conditions of this race. The track reserves the right to hold trials on this race as non-wagering or at their discretion.

QUALIFIERS – If a horse that qualified for the final should be unable to enter, *or race*, due to racing unsoundness, illness, multiple bleeder, death or scratched for any reason other than a positive drug test or a rule violation, such horse or horses shall receive **last place purse money**. If more than one horse is scratched from the final, then those purse monies shall be added together and divided equally among those owners.

CONSOLATION - Those horses that competed in the trials for the Futurity who did not qualify for the final shall be eligible to enter the consolation. Preference shall be given to those horses who posted the fastest non-qualifying times, starting with the eleventh fastest time if one day of trials. If there are 2 days of trials the 11th – 20th times will be taken from day 1 times 6th – 10th and day 2 times 6 – 10th.

DISQUALIFICATION – *If a qualifier for the final is disqualified due to a positive drug test or other rule violation (exclusive of a multiple bleeder) after the time trials are declared official, but prior to entry for the final, the non-qualifier with the next fastest time shall replace the disqualified horse.* If a qualifier is disqualified after entry for the final for any reason other than racing unsoundness, illness, multiple bleeder or death, the purse shall be redistributed, *among the remaining qualifiers*, in accordance with the purse distribution percentages.

Louisiana Quarter Horse Breeders Association reserves the right to cancel, postpone or change the location of the race (trials or finals) for any reason which it deems good and sufficient. LQHBA shall have the authority to blood test/D.N.A. test the first three (3) finishers and/or all horses entered in this futurity and also reserves the right to have its track veterinarian mouth or inspect any nominee for age any time after arrival of nominees at the track.

An owner may nominate as many entries as desired. If any one or more are withdrawn before the race, be sure to specify which ones are so withdrawn when making payment. Please notify the LQHBA of any sale of nominees or change of address of owner.

Nomination or subscriptions to this stake may be refused or cancelled without any liability at any time prior to the actual running thereof, except for the return of any nomination and entry fees paid.

When Time Trials are conducted on two days, the racing secretary shall make **his/her best effort to** split owners with more than one entry into separate days **and/or time trials**.

THE DECISION OF THE STEWARDS AND/OR THE LOUISIANA STATE RACING COMMISSION IN ALL MATTERS UNDER THEIR JURISDICTION SHALL BE FINAL
